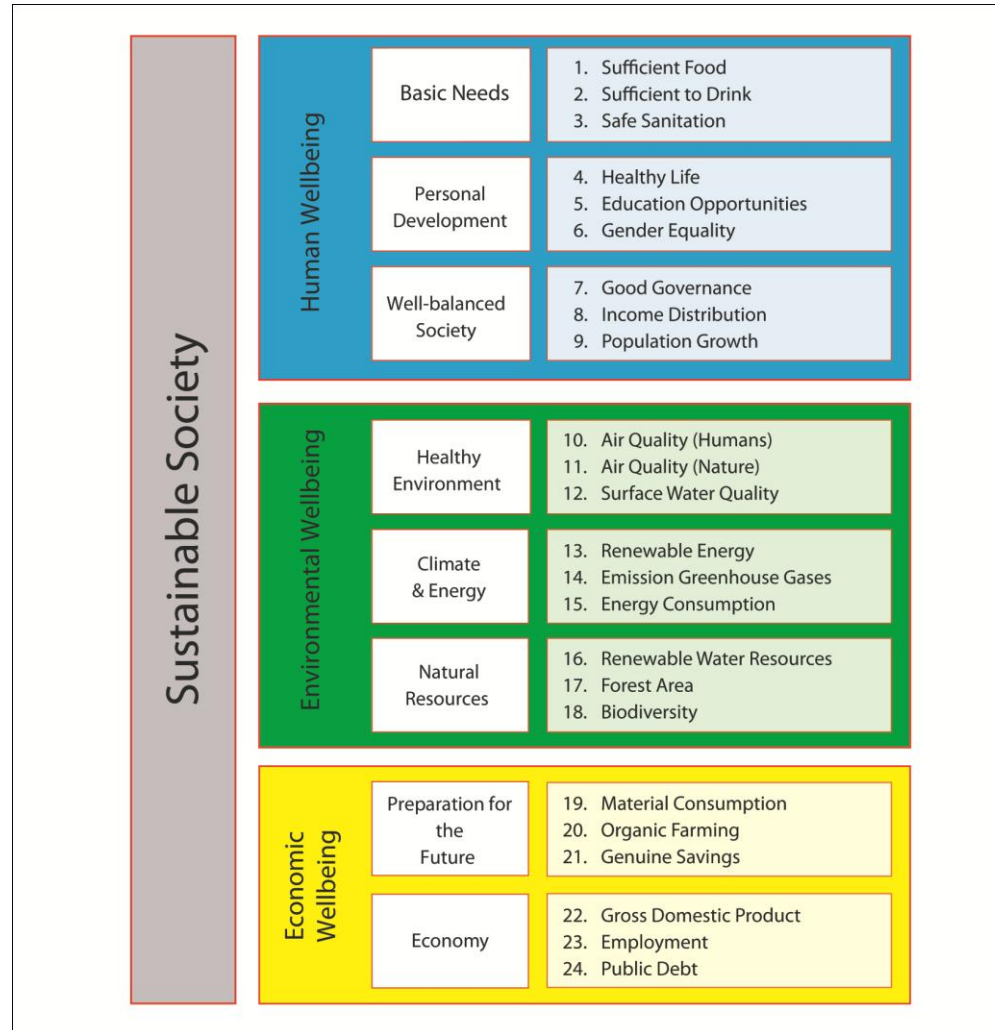

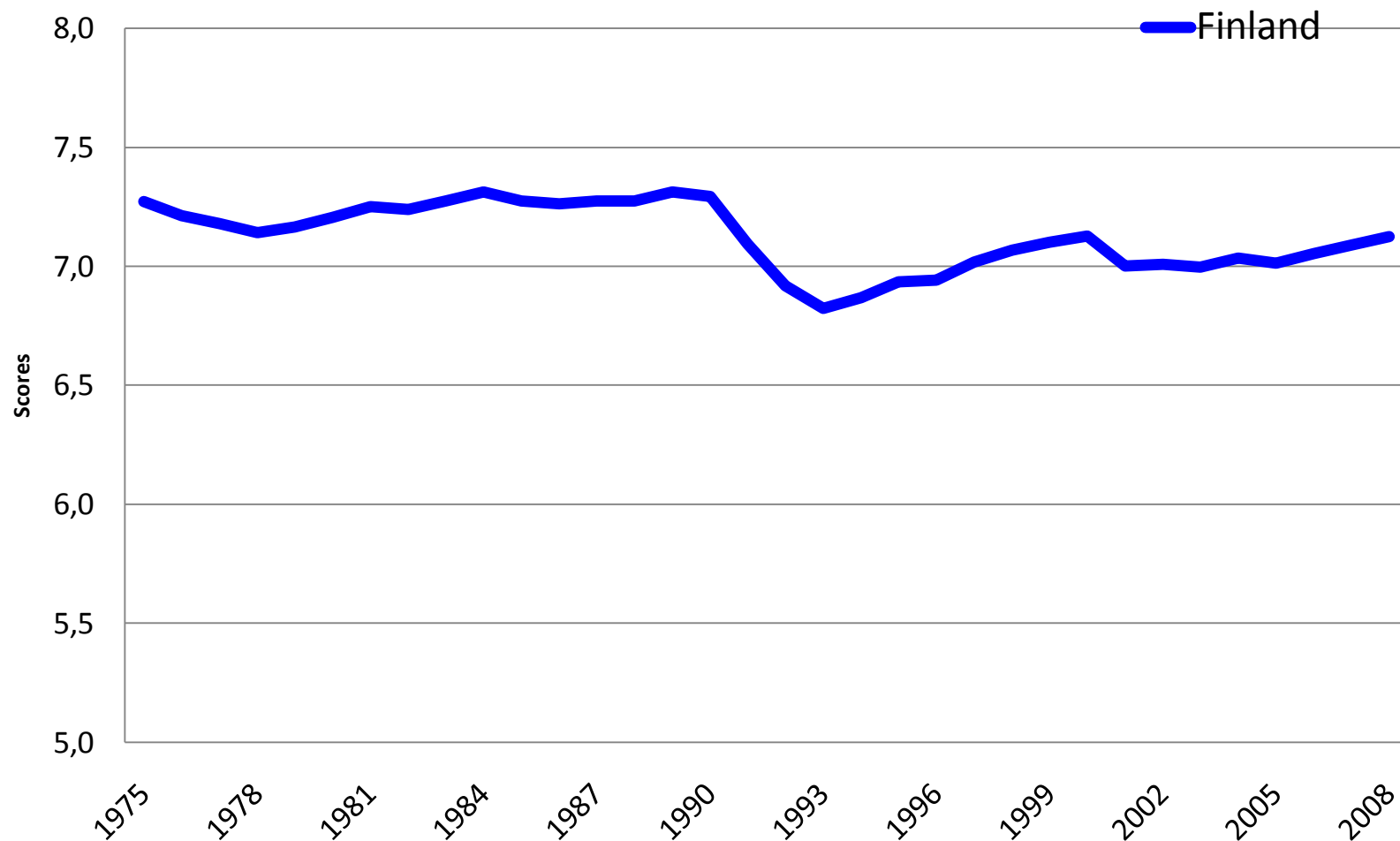

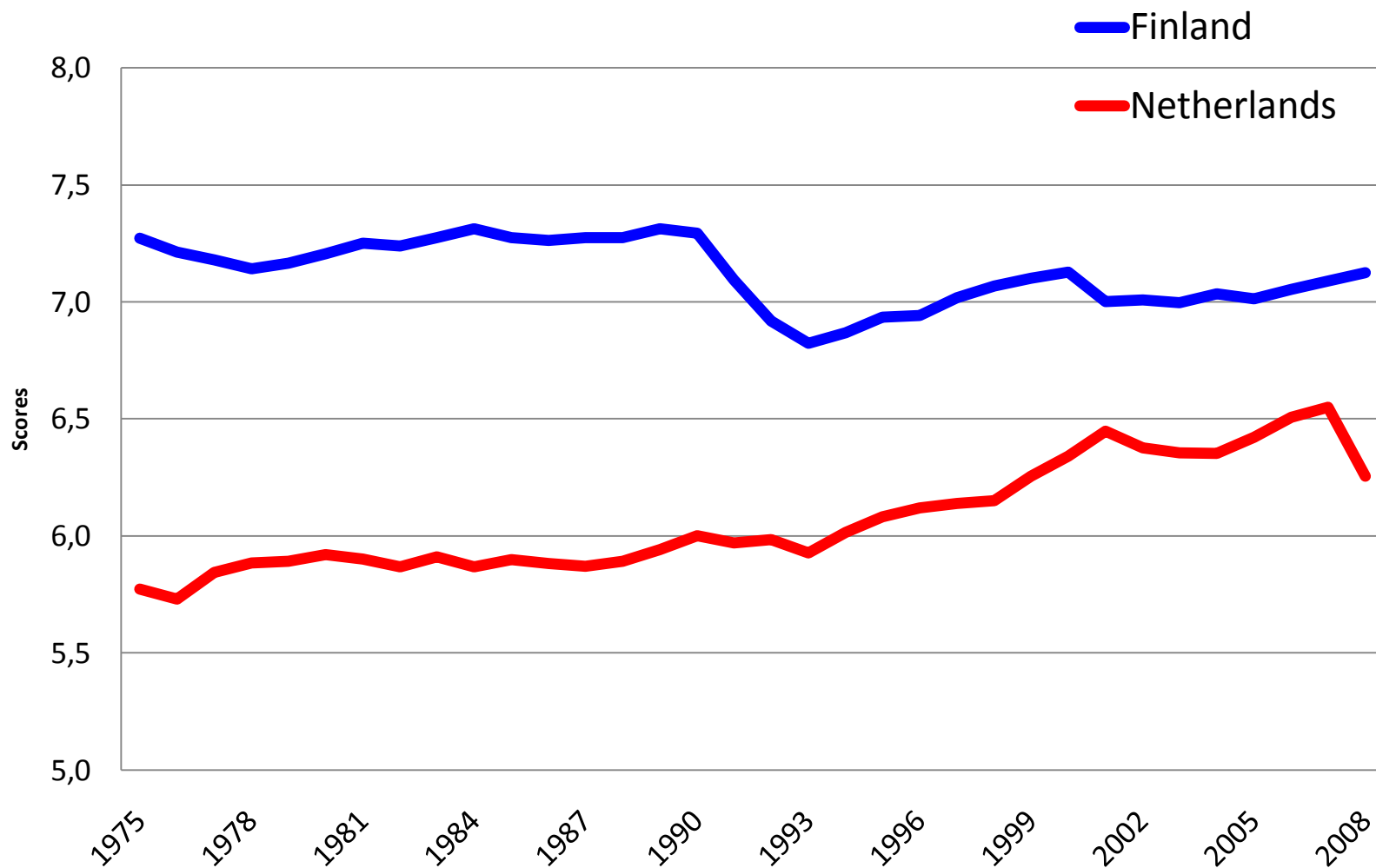




SSI 1975-2008

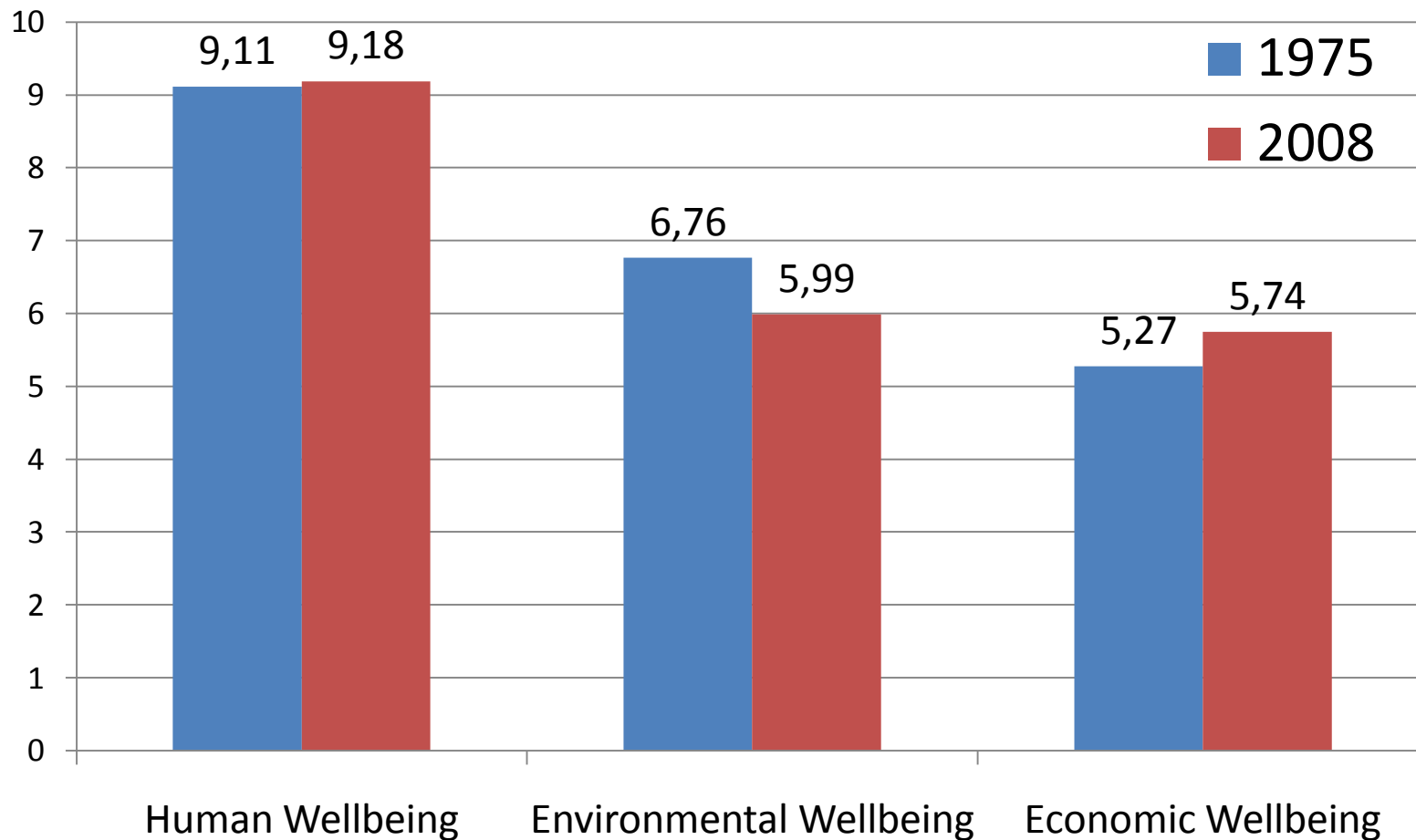

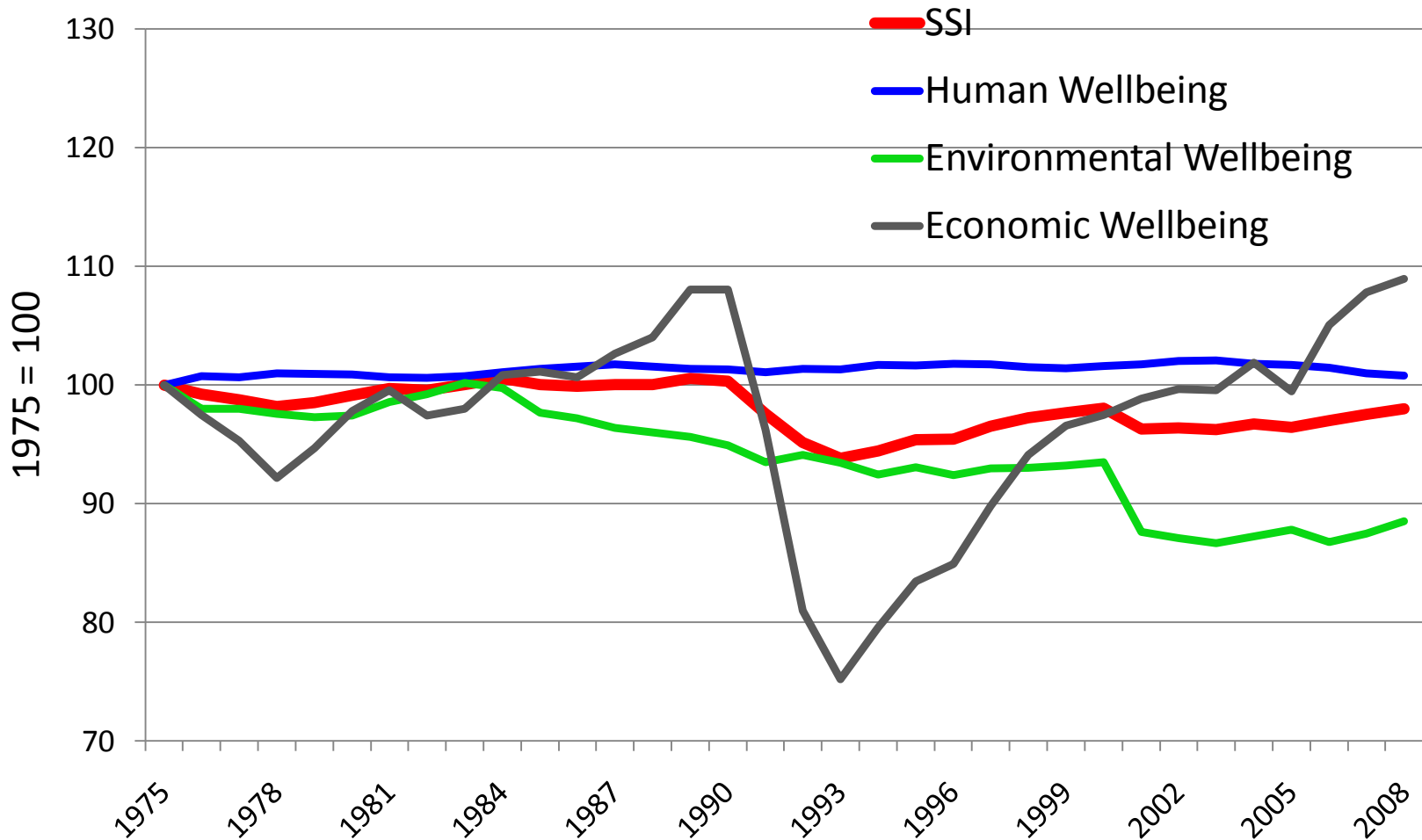

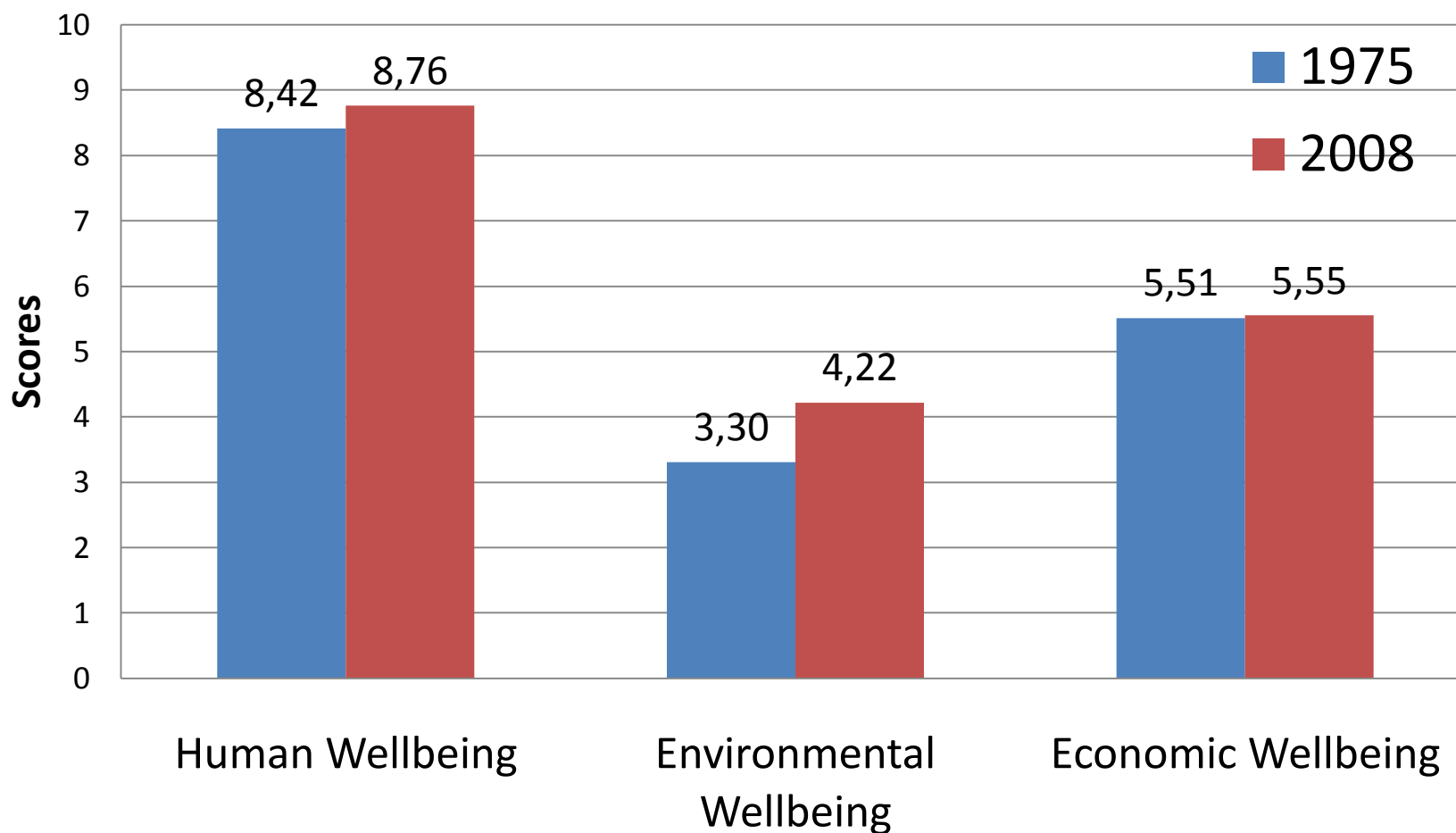


SSI Finland 1975 - 2008



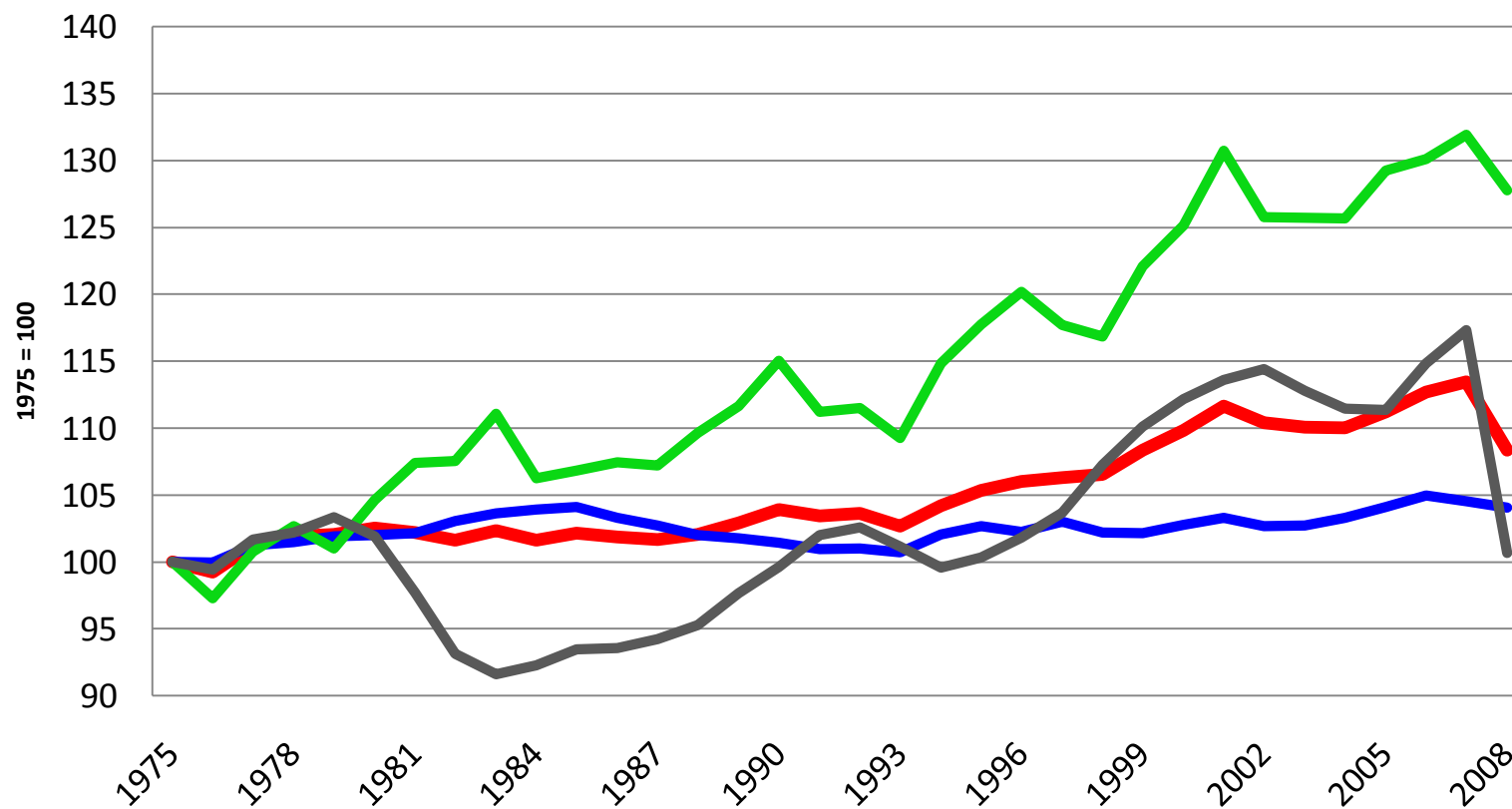

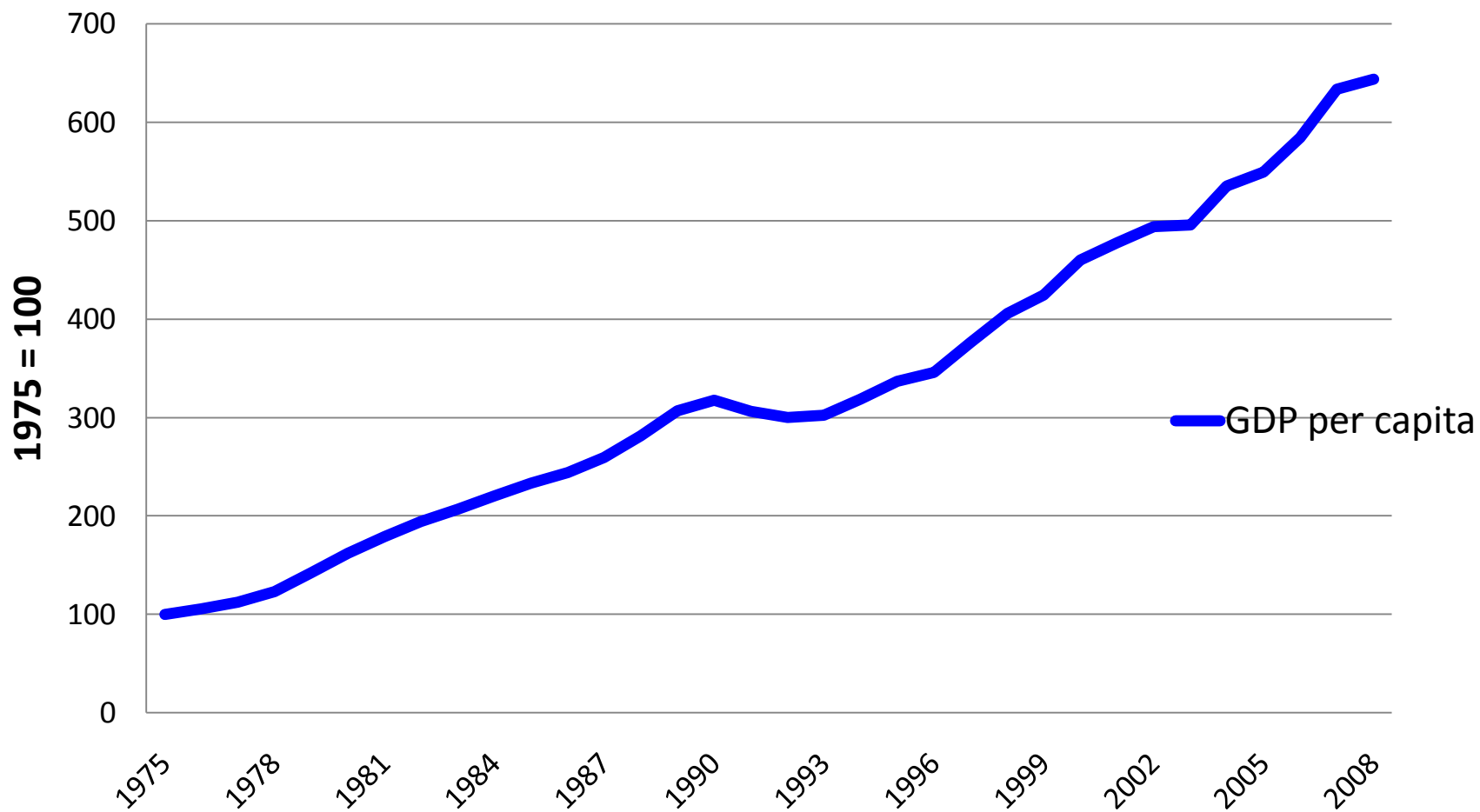


SSI The Netherlands 1975 - 2008



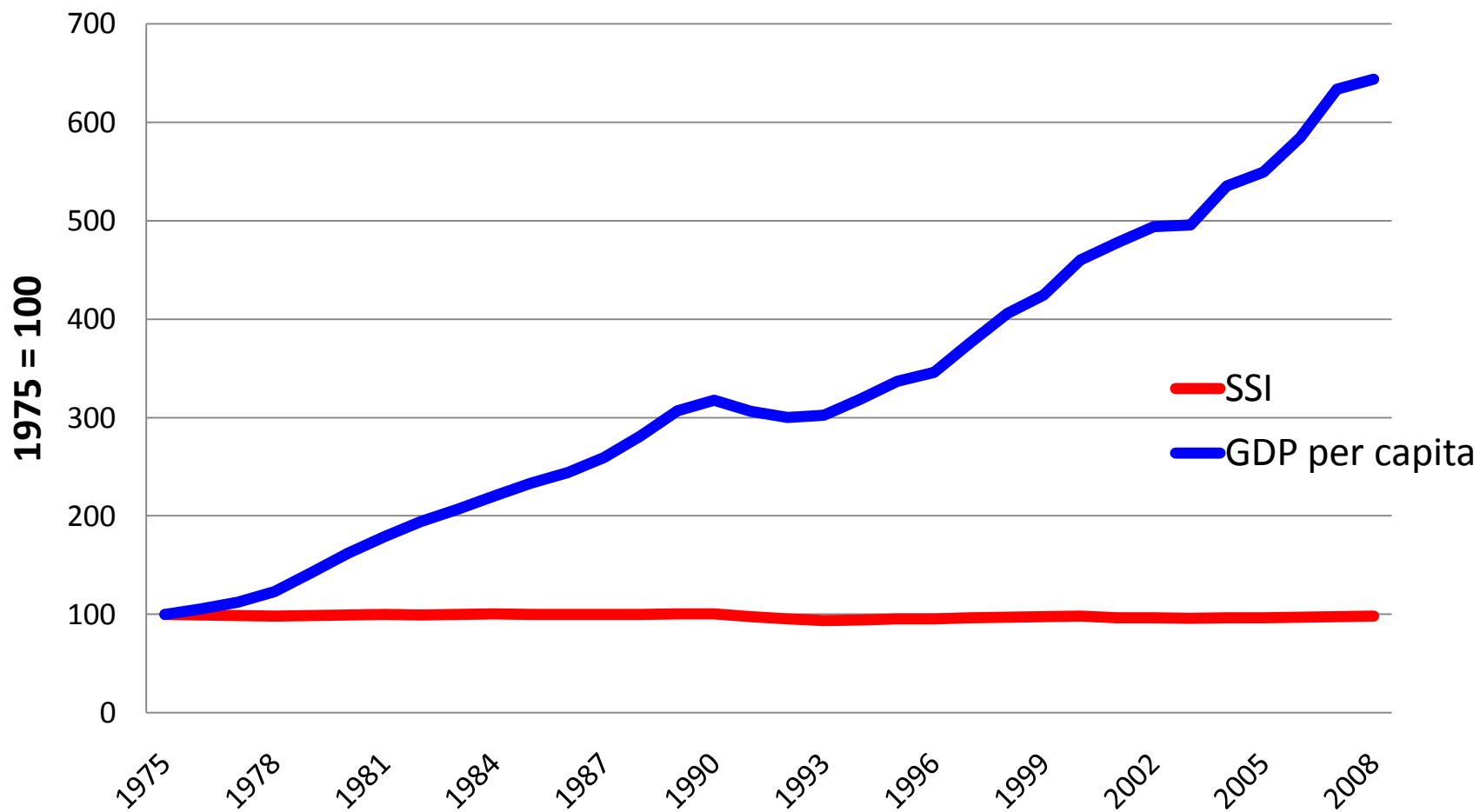


GDP – SSI Finland



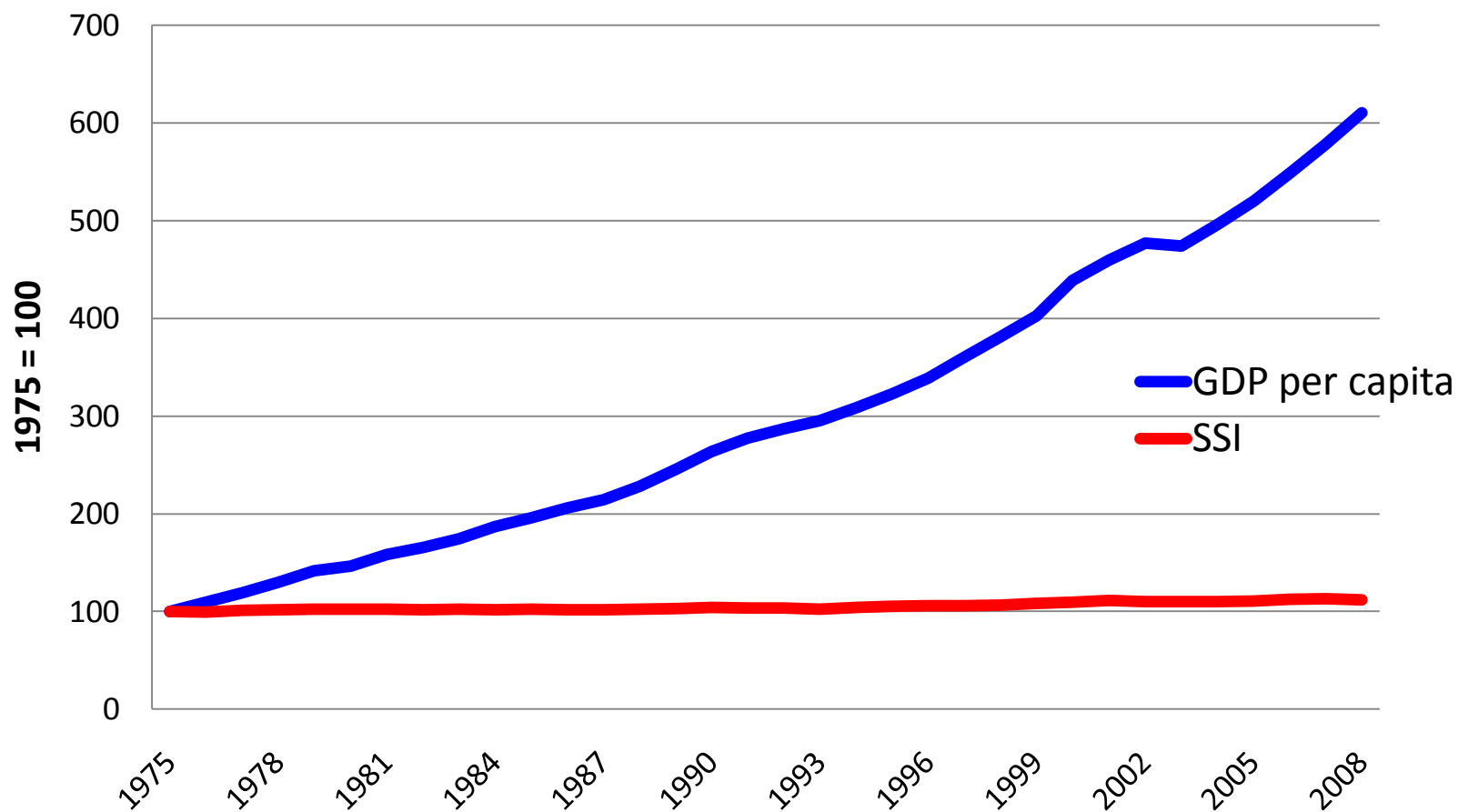


GDP – SSI Finland





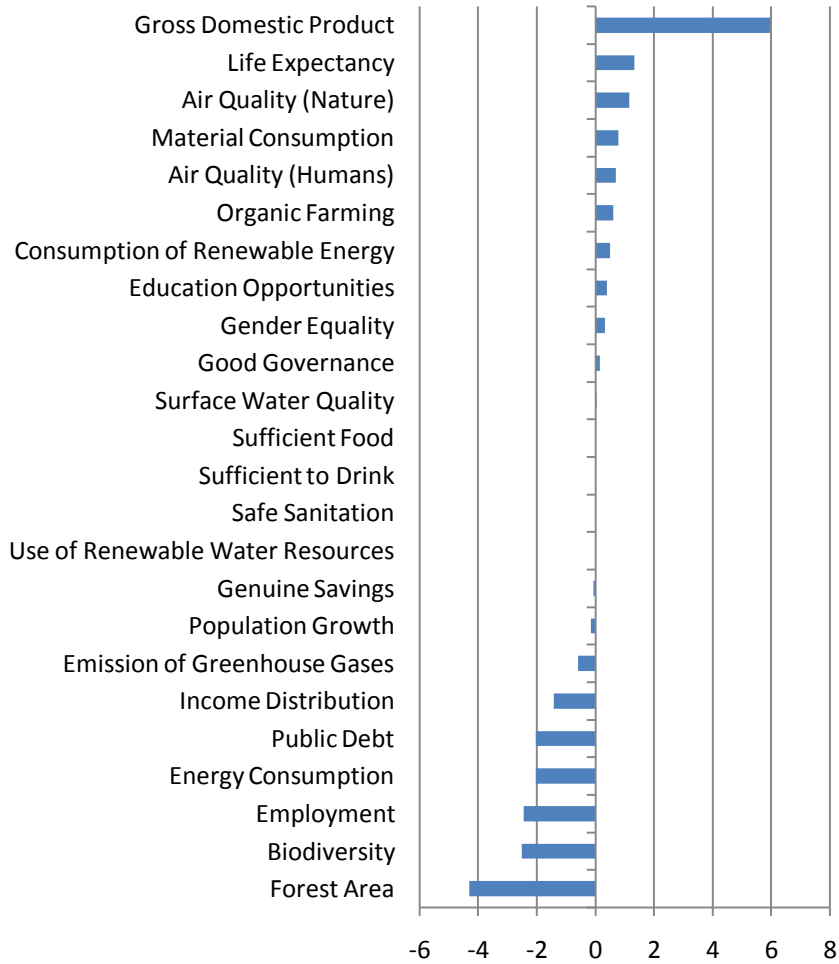
GDP – SSI The Netherlands



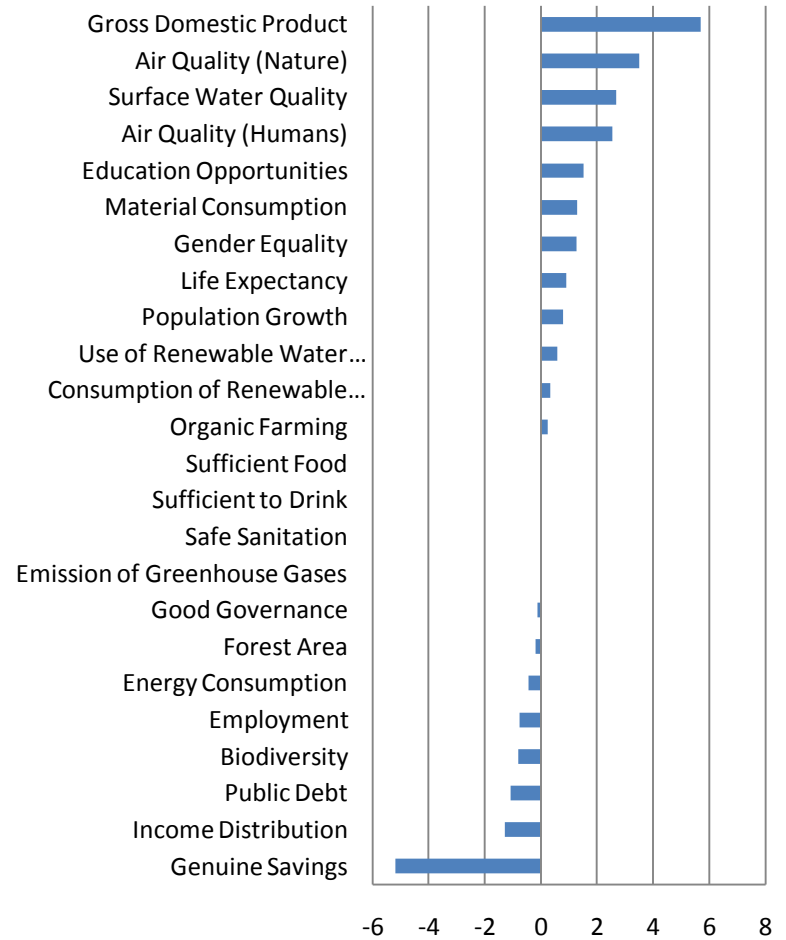
Changes indicator scores 1975 - 2008

Conclusions

1. Finland scores better on the SSI across 75-08 than The Netherlands.
2. The trend for Finland was slightly downwards, since 1993 upwards.
3. For The Netherlands the trend is slightly upwards.
4. Both countries have largely increased the GDP per capita. However, this has not resulted in a substantial increase of sustainability.

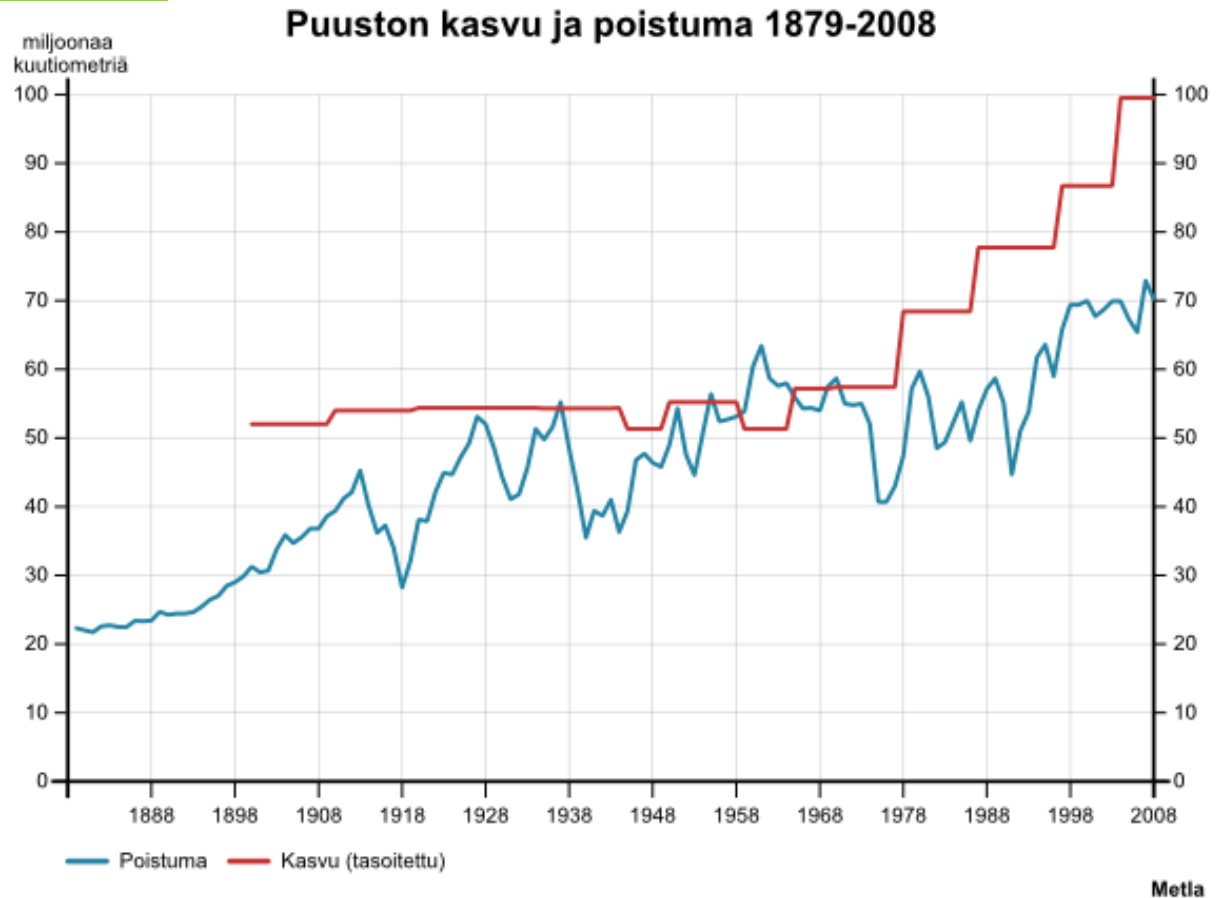

 - National set of SD indicators – key indicators in the NSDS
 - A specific set of indicators to support the political discussion in SD council meetings
- New government program (22.6.2010): “develop and introduce in a couple of years a complementary indicator for the GDP to measure societal progress, wellbeing and state of the environment” – a task for the FNCSD?
