

- In 2021, at Expo Dubai, we presented the cultural project: "Sustainable Romania Local Knowledge from the Past for a Global Lasting Future", based on the contribution of the 3 great romanian personalities: Antipa, Brâncuşi, Roegen
- In 2022 another cultural project was carried out: the National Educational Theatre Caravan - The 17 Magnificent Ones Who Changed the Future. For the project implementation, more than 50 teenagers from the 8 regions were brought together. Through live representations or online streming, thousands of teenagers learned more about SDGs enjoying a cultural act
