FINANCING INSTRUMENT

Fund on Environment

- PNDD – national plan for sustainable development
- specifies priority areas for action, concrete objectives and actions to be taken with a view to sustainable development
- political document for which the government assumes ultimate responsibility

LAW of 25 June 2004 on the coordination of national sustainable development policy

Sets out the legal framework, establishes a well-defined institutional structure, designates a series of instruments

Sustainable development indicators

- integral part of the national report
- should serve as a tool for measuring progress towards sustainable development.

National sustainable development implementation report

- describes Luxembourg's sustainable development situation
- should assess, on the basis of relevant hypotheses, the consequences of action or inaction in terms of sustainable development.

Missions

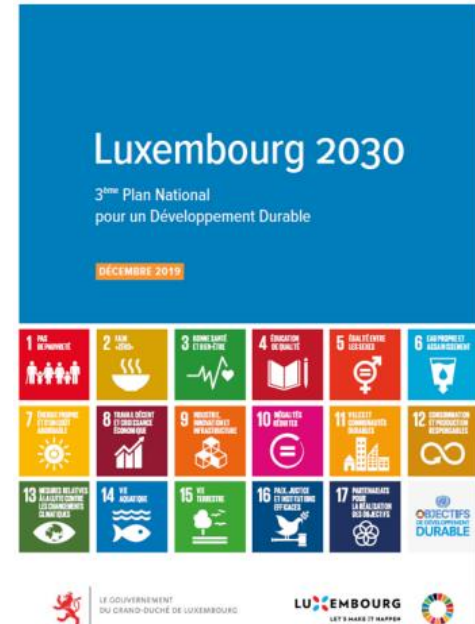
- 15 Representatives of civil society, research and the private sector as individuals
 - body for reflection, discussion and advice on sustainable development
- Opinions concerning sustainable development policy (referred or self-referred) – ex: opinion on proposal for food policy
 - Think Tank (long-term view) –ex: advice on better taxation
 - Awareness-raising (general public) (ex. Ecological footprint, CO2 emission calculator..)
 - Actually work on unsustainable growth



Chamber of Deputies/ Parliament

- advises the national plan on sustainable development
- takes note of the national report on the implementation of sustainable development

- Takes note of the report of the High Council for Sustainable Development





Interministerial Committee for sustainable development

- made up of representatives from each ministerial department
- prepares the preliminary draft of the PNDD and the national report on sustainable development

- ensures that sustainable development is integrated into sectoral policies
- **Especially in this context: elaborated the sustainability check on laws! www.nohalteg.lu**





Civil society

- NGOs, private sector, municipalities...
- Must be consulted on the subject of sustainable development
- Series of workshop organized to review the proposal of the national sustainable development plan

➤ Especially:

Adaptation of the national sustainable development plan and integration of three more priorities proposed by civil society !



Financing instruments

- High Council on Sustainable has a dedicated budget
- New environmental fund creates support for sustainable development
 - Committee deciding on the projects

- **New project to support efforts for sustainable development of the municipalities!**
